**\$25**

= A Family First Aid Kit to help a family be prepared in case of an emergency

= School clothes for a student in need

= Five rides for seniors to pick up prescriptions

**\$50**

= An aquatic bodywork session for a person with a disability

= Fitness class equipment for five senior citizens for one year

= Ten student tutor training and resource packets

**\$75**

= Materials for one adult to receive their GED

= 180—1/2 gallons of milk, averaging 90 families being served by that amount

= 15 rides for seniors for grocery shopping

= Trip and visit for three people to the physician clinic for an identified health need

= Opportunity for a troop of ten girls to attend a science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) program

**\$250**

= Rent for two cabins at summer camp for 40 people with a disability

= Shelter for a parent and child for one month

= Food, shelter, opportunity for employment, structured activities and drug education in a safe sober residence for one month for one woman
